### Provider Type Descriptions

**Allied Health Practitioners** includes non-physician health care practitioners such as podiatrists, optometrists, Certified Nurse Practitioners (CNPs), chiropractors, Certified Nurse Anesthetists (CRNAs), Physical Therapists (PTs), Occupational Therapists (OTs), speech therapists, nutritionists, acupuncturists (Doctors of Oriental Medicine in New Mexico), audiologists, and licensed midwives.

**Ancillary Services** includes auxiliary or supplemental services such as diagnostic services (X-rays), home health services, physical therapy and occupational therapy facilities.

**Behavioral Health Facilities** includes in-patient or out-patient psychiatric facilities.

**Behavioral Health Practitioners** includes mental health professionals such as psychiatrists (MDs), psychologists, licensed counselors, and licensed social workers.

**Hospitals** include acute care hospitals, children's acute care hospitals and specialty hospitals. This category also includes the addition of Indian Health Services (IHS) hospitals that serve the Native American population covered under BCBSNM.

**Primary Care Physicians** includes Family Practice, Internal Medicine, General Practice, Pediatrics, and Obstetrics/Gynecology physicians.

**Primary Care Providers** includes Certified Nurse Practitioners (CNPs) that serve as PCPs in the following specialties: Family Practice, Internal Medicine, General Practice, Pediatrics, and Obstetrics/Gynecology.

**Specialists** include physicians that provide specialty care. Examples include: Surgery, Allergy & Immunology, Cardiology, Dermatology, Gastroenterology, Ear, Nose and Throat, Endocrinology, Neurology, Nephrology, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Pulmonology, Urology, etc. This category also includes hospital based physicians such as anesthesiologists, critical care medicine, etc.
