Definition of Specialty Drugs

Specialty medications are generally prescribed for people with complex or ongoing medical conditions such as multiple sclerosis, hemophilia, hepatitis, and rheumatoid arthritis. These high cost medications also typically have one or more of the following characteristics:

- Injected or infused, but some may be taken by mouth
- Unique storage or shipment requirements
- Additional education and support required from a health care professional
- Usually not stocked at retail pharmacies

How do I use the BCBSNM specialty pharmacy program?

Call 888.216.6710. You will need your prescription information, the prescribing physician contact information and your health plan ID card. A Triessent care coordinator will collect the information needed to initiate the enrollment process.

How do I obtain refills?

A patient care coordinator will call to schedule your refill, based on treatment information provided by you and your doctor. Or you can call Triessent at 888.216.6710 and a care coordinator will help you.

Will all of my prescription medications be dispensed through the BCBSNM specialty pharmacy program?

No. Only select injectable and oral medications will be dispensed through the BCBSNM specialty pharmacy program. You will continue to receive any non-specialty medications through PrimeMail® or your retail pharmacy.

Does Triessent have to arrange for my delivery every time I get a new shipment of medication?

Yes. Specialty medications typically require special handling and storage. Regular contact from a care coordinator provides assistance in getting the most from your therapy. Medications can be delivered to the location most convenient for you, including your home, workplace or doctor's office.

How will my out-of-pocket costs be affected if I decide to use the BCBSNM specialty pharmacy program?

If you use the BCBSNM specialty pharmacy program, you will pay your plan's applicable coinsurance or copay amount for the specialty medication. Your out-of-pocket pharmacy costs will be higher at out of network specialty pharmacies.
